The Short Loan Room

The Short Loan room holds copies of books that are in high demand by students.

If a book is required reading, at least one copy of this book will be in the Short Loan Room.

It is also where all the photocopiers are.

Can you locate where the Short Loan Room is in the Library?

Either the room number (on the door) or a description of its location will be fine.

Looking for Journals

The Library holds thousands of books – most of them are on the ground floor.

You can also find many journals, or magazines, which come into the Library on a regular basis.

There are some useful journals in your area, for example, 3D World. We get a new issue every month.

Find the latest issue of 3D World on the journal shelves, on the first floor of the Library.

You can use the online Library Catalogue – available at <http://library.ulster.ac.uk/catalogue> to find the shelf number – type in *3D world* in the title search on the Library Catalogue. Find the latest issue (September 2008), and describe the front cover.

Ask for help if necessary.
